

BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

In order to be considered, all nominations of potential board members must be accompanied by a completed 'Application for Membership.' All applications will be evaluated by comparison with demographic, ethnic and professional needs for the board of directors. Current board members may meet with potential applicants in order to gain a better understanding of each individual. Receipt of a completed application will be regarded as an expression of interest, not acceptance or commitment to serve.

Regular board meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month, six times per year. All board members will be required to serve on one or two regular committees. Applicants who believe that attendance may be a problem should consider delaying application. Regular attendance is vitally important to being a board member. Additionally, all board members are expected to attend 2 to 3 yearly functions that include, but are not limited to the Annual Candle Light Vigil and Annual Volunteer Appreciation Party. Any individual who is receiving service from the Crisis Center of Comal County may not serve as a volunteer until 90 days after the last day of receiving services.
